Hazardous Material Spill

Outside Spill: upon notification of a hazardous material spill the following announcement will be made.

CODE BROWN Announcment: There has been a hazardous material spill outside the building. Teachers, secure your classroom and take proper precautions.

- 1. Close all windows and doors.
- 2. Turn off all ventilation including furnaces, air conditioning, vents or vans, anything through which polluted outside air could get into the building.
- 3. If you are outside get into a building or vehicle or move to a safe place crosswind.
- 4. Emergency services or the RCMP/fire department normally assume the lead role in such emergencies and will:
 - a. contact the school regarding the danger
 - b. provide direction as to a course of action
- 5. School administration is to comply with the directions given above.
- 6. Administration, in the event of evacuation, will:
 - a. contact buses to transport students and staff to evacuation locations or home
 - b. contact the director or designate
 - c. contact parents
- 7. Staff are to remain with students until released from their duties by school administration.
- 8. The director may implement the communication plan.
- 9. Debriefing and counseling will occur if deemed necessary.

Inside Spill: Upon notification of a hazardous material spill, the following announcement will be made:

CODE BROWN: There has been a hazardous material spill inside the building. Teachers, secure your classroom and take proper precautions.

- 1. Close all windows and doors.
- 2. Turn off all ventilation anything through which polluted air might move within the building.
- 3. The staff member encountering a hazardous material spill will:
 - a. evacuate the affected area and isolate it (if possible) from student or staff entry
 - b. check for injured students or staff
 - c. notify school administration
- 4. Administration will:
 - a. assess the situation and seek the assistance of emergency services if necessary
 - b. enact evacuation procedures if required
 - c. contact the director or designate
- 5. The director may implement the communication plan.
- 6. Debriefing and counseling will occur if deemed necessary.
